



She asked to see the fish, looked, and with a big smile said, "Tadpoles. – Wow! You are in for a surprise."




I asked what she meant and she just said that I would have to wait and see, but to watch my fish Carefully.

She came into my room, looked, smiled, and told me to keep watching.




After several more weeks,

My fish didn't have tails, their legs were bigger, and they didn't look like the little black fish I had caught earlier in the Spring.




"Mom," I yelled with excitement.
