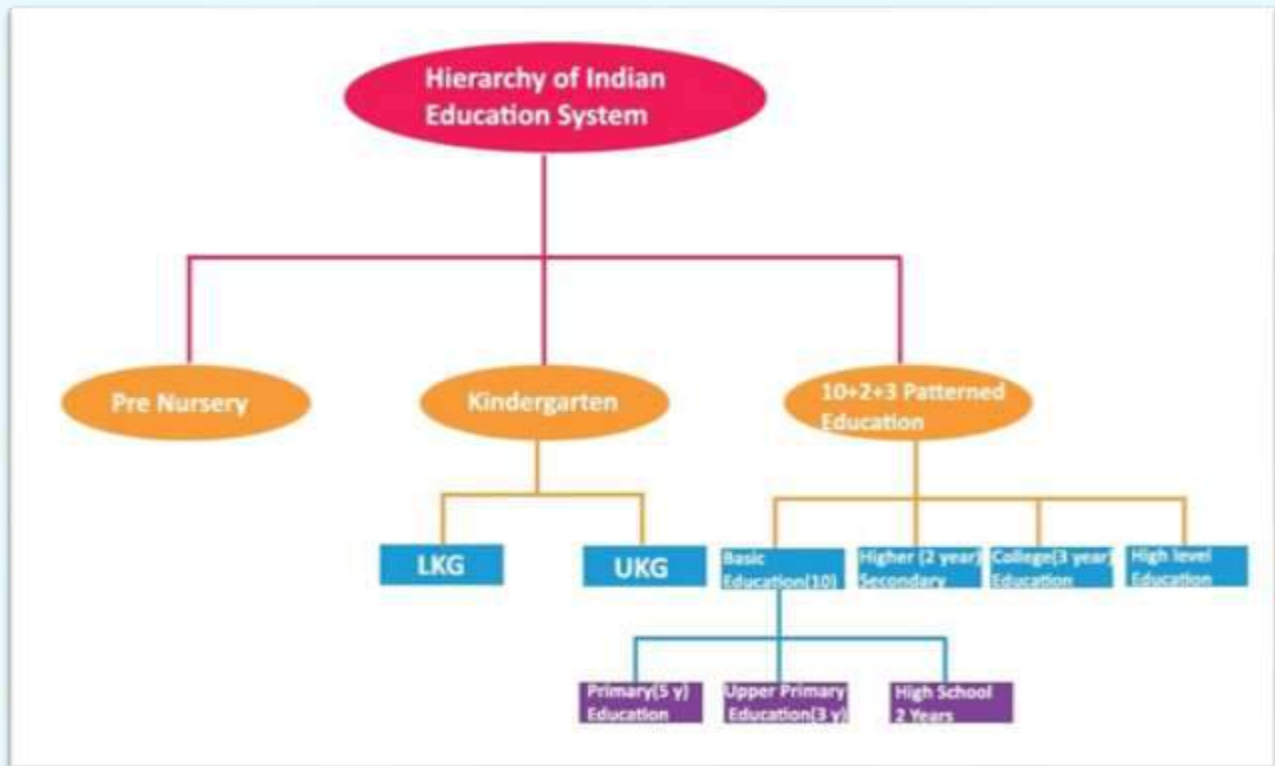

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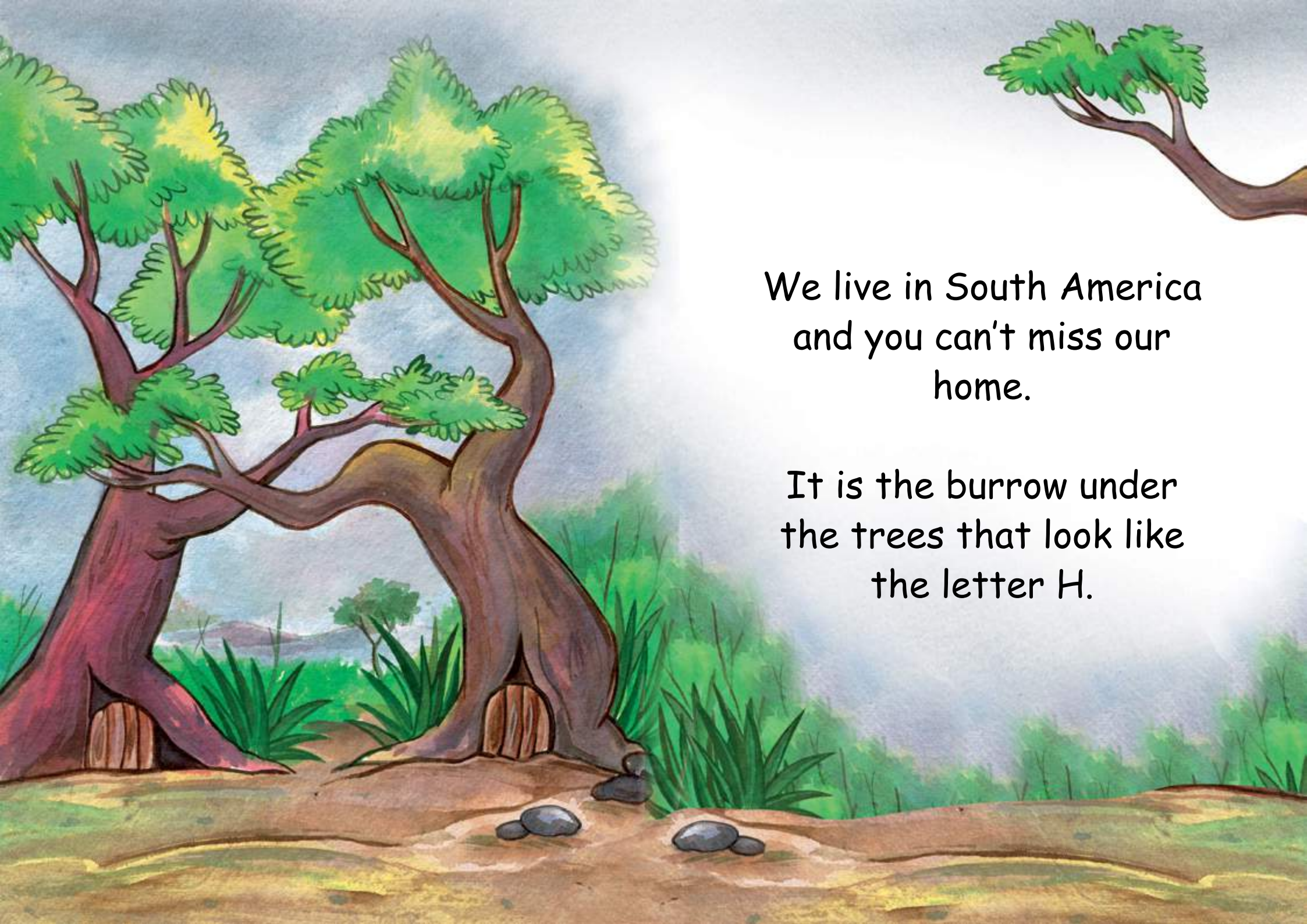


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I am Hammy the Hamster.

When we are out during the day, we are very careful so we aren't caught.



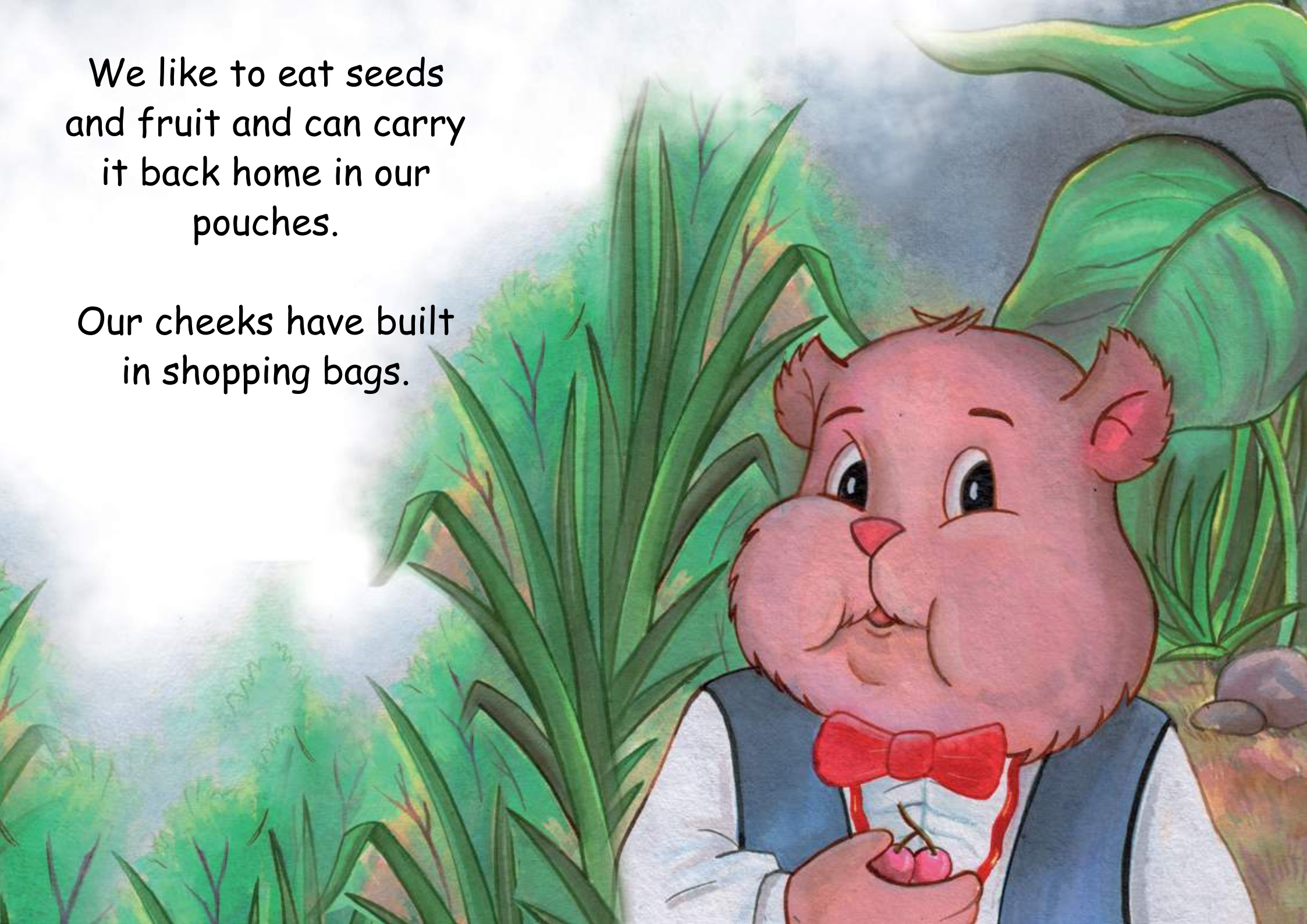


We might get

someone's pet.

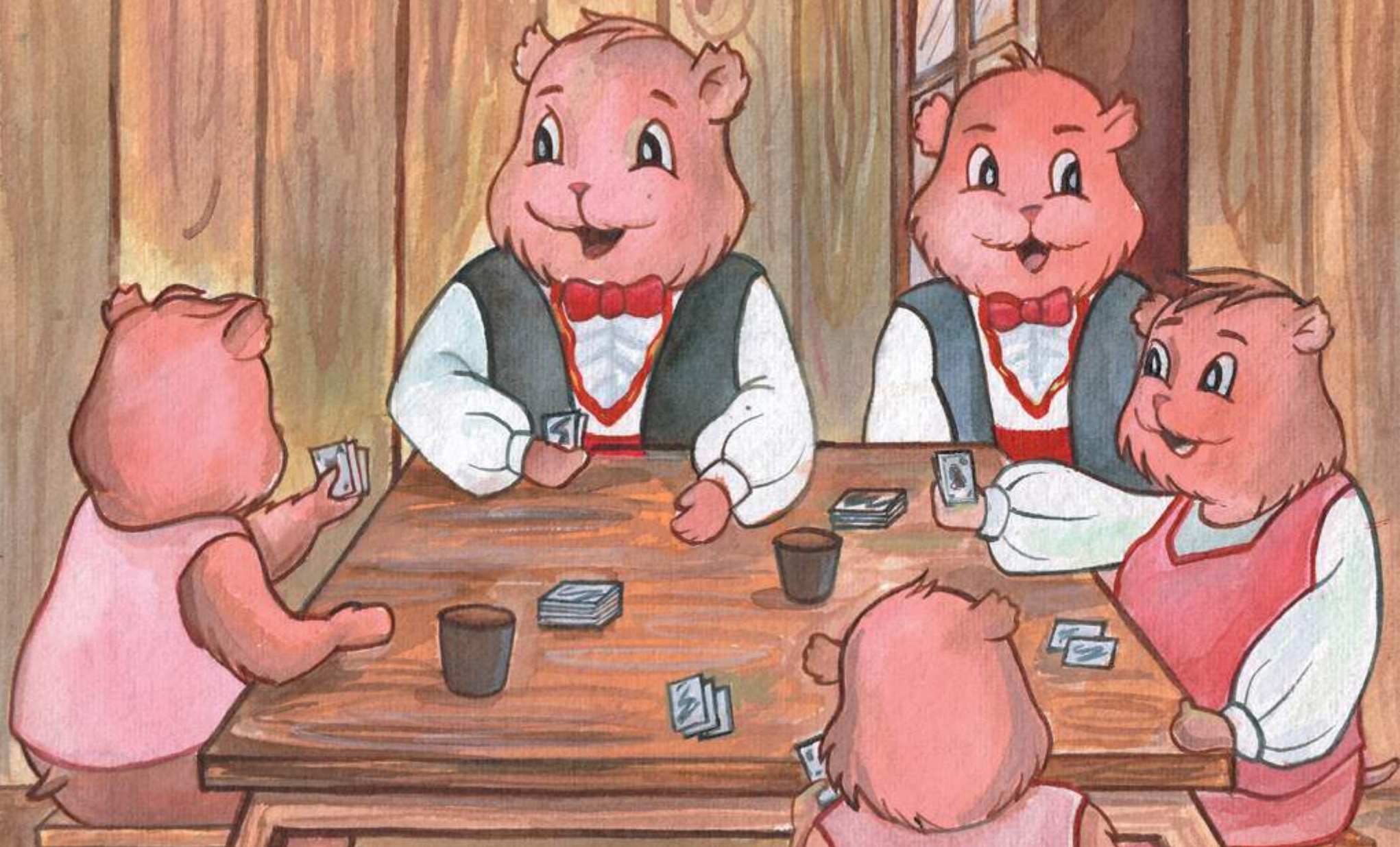
So we are

in shopping bags.



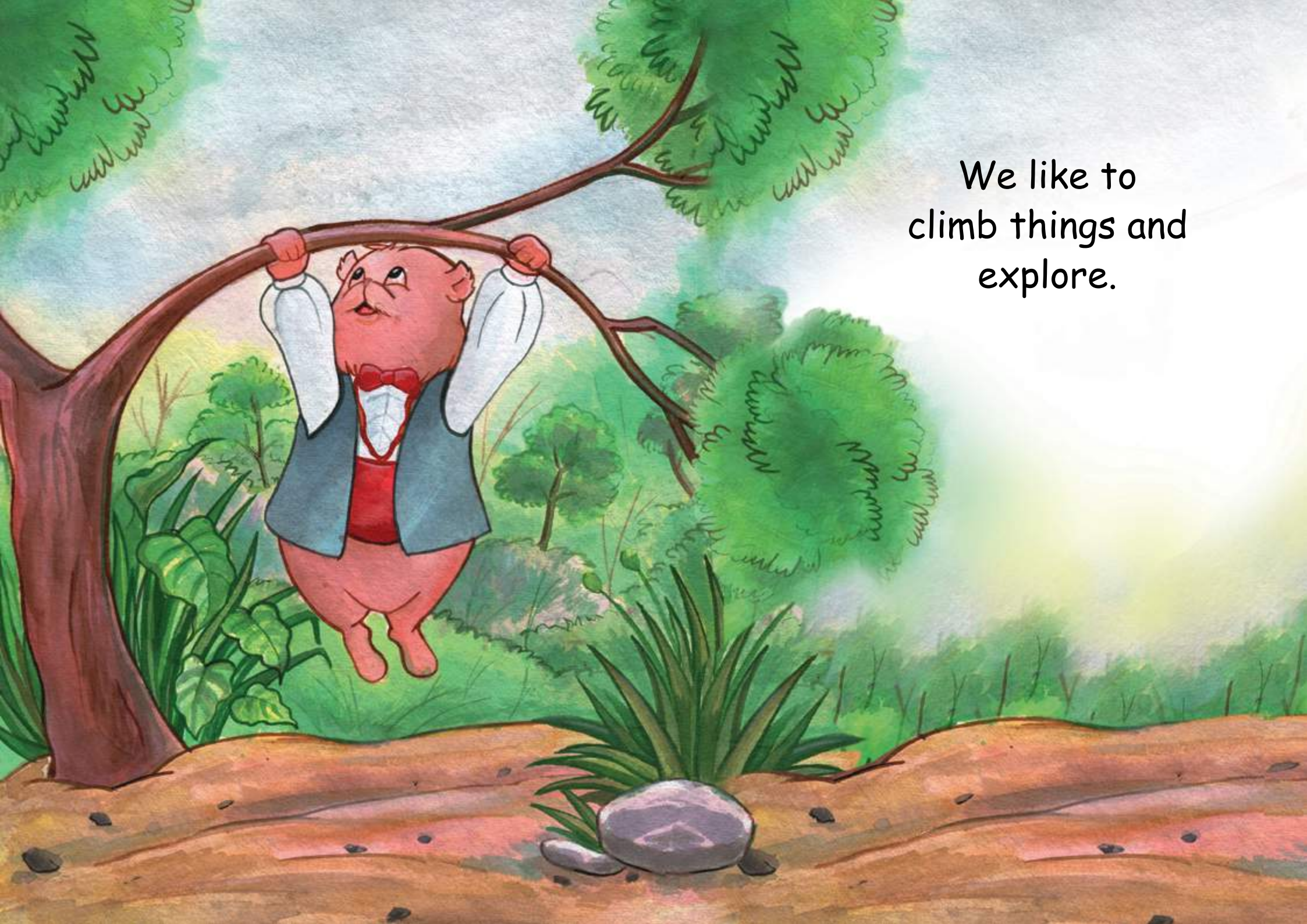
Just like you, we like to
