




SUMMER BREAK ASSIGNMENTS

Holiday homework to be submitted on the first day of school after summer vacation to the class in-charge and subject teachers respectively.






STEPS involved

- Share the video of your recording with your class teacher on her personal number.






Summer vacations are meant for fun and full of enjoyment with family and friends. It's time for children to play, enjoy, relax and re- energize.
